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ORDER:

During the Demand for Grants for the Water Resources Department for the year 2021 - 2022 held on 23.8.2021, the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources on the floor of the Assembly has announced that "190 Check dams, 4 Subsurface dykes, 6 Barrages, 2 Tail end Regulators and 12 Anicuts in all Districts will be constructed during the current Financial year".

2. Based on the above announcement, the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department in his letter first read above, has sent a proposal for the work of Construction of 2 Nos. of Check dams in Madurai Region at an estimated cost of Rs.4.56 Crore and the Schemes envisage the following:

- (i). Construction of a Check Dam across the Nagalar Odai near S.F.No:107 in Kothappatti Village of Andipatti Taluk in Theni District at an estimated cost of Rs.2.14 crore

The proposed Check Dam site is located across the Nagalar Odai near S.F.No:107 in Kothappatti Village of Andipatti Taluk in Theni District. The proposed check dam lies in Vaigai basin and Varattar Nagalar sub basin.

- (ii). Construction of a Check dam across the Gowsigariver near Kuppampatti Village in Virudhunagar Taluk and District at an estimated cost of Rs.2.55 crore

The proposed Check Dam site is located across the Gowsigariver near Kuppampatti Village in Virudhunagar Taluk of Virudhunagar District. The proposed Check Dam lies in Vaippar basin and Gowshikanadhi sub basin.

3. The Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department has informed that the above schemes have been prepared based on the Schedule of Rates for the Year 2021-22 and no land acquisition is involved in these schemes and requested to accord administrative sanction for the proposal for "Construction of 2 Nos. of Check dams in Madurai Region at an estimated cost of Rs.4.69 Crore

4. In the letter second read above, the proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department for the above Check Dams have been forwarded to NABARD for loan assistance under RIDF XXVII for the year 2021-2022 at a restricted cost to Rs.4.56 Crore.

5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department in anticipation of loan assistance from NABARD. Accordingly, administrative sanction is accorded for construction of 2 nos. of Check Dams at an estimated cost of Rs.4,56,00,000/- (Rupees Four crore and fifty six lakh only) in anticipation of NABARD loan assistance under RIDF XXVII for 2021-2022, as follows:

A sum of Rs.20,01,000/- (Rupees Twenty lakh and one thousand only) is earmarked for financial year 2021 – 2022 and the balance is for subsequent financial year.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Services" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by drawal of an Advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is directed to send necessary proposal to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 with a copy of this order for sanction of an Advance from the Contingency Fund. He is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes for

inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2021-2022 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.5308/PW-II/2022, dated. 14.02.2022 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1602 (One thousand, Six hundred and two).
