Water Resources Department – Announcement for the year 2021-2022 made by the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources - Construction of an Anicut across the Thenar River to feed Oyyakondan tank and other tanks near O.Siruvayal Village of Karaikudi Taluk in Sivagangai District at an estimated cost of Rs.5.42 Crore - Sanction accorded – Orders - Issued.

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ORDER:

During the Water Resources Department's Demand for grants for the year 2021-2022 held on 23.08.2021, the Hon'ble Minister of Water Resources has announced on the floor of the Assembly that "190 Check dams, 4 Subsurface dykes, 6 Barrages, 2 Tail end Regulators and 12 Anicuts in all Districts will be constructed during the current Financial year".

2. Based on the above announcement, the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department in his letter first read above, has sent a proposal for the Work of Construction of an Anicut across the Thenar River to feed Oyyakondan tank and other tanks near O.Siruvayal

Village of Karaikudi Taluk in Sivagangai District at an estimated cost of Rs.5.42 Crore and the Work envisages the following:

- (a) The proposed anicut is located across the Thenar River to feed Oyyakondan tank and other tanks near O.Siruvayal Village of Karaikudi Taluk in Sivagangai District. The anicut site is located in Pambar Kottakaraiyar basin and Manimuthar sub basin.
- (b) The ayacutdhars of Oyyakondan tank represented often that they have not received water through the already existing old open offtake due to lowering of river bed and hence to construct an anicut near the existing open offtake in O.Siruvayal side off-take and Sangudi (or) Siruvayal Periya tank, Patharakudi tank, Elangattan tank through right side off take.
- (c) Hence, it is proposed to construct an anicut and two head regulators across the Thenar River to feed the above said tanks of Karaikudi Taluk in Sivagangai District
- (d) The scheme cost works out to Rs.5.50 crore. The BC ratio of the scheme is work out to 4.81:1 and the rate per hectare is Rs.356957.42/-.

3. The Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department has informed that the above scheme has been prepared based on the Schedule of Rates for the Year 2021-22 and requested to accord Administrative Sanction for the proposal for "Construction of an Anicut across the Thenar River to feed Oyyakondan tank and other tanks near O.Siruvayal Village of Karaikudi Taluk in Sivagangai District at an estimated cost of Rs.5.50 Crore

4. In the letter second read above, the proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department for the above Check Dam has been forwarded to NABARD for loan assistance under RIDF XXVII for the year 2021-2022 at a restricted cost of Rs.5.42 Crore.

5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department in anticipation of loan assistance from NABARD under RIDF. Accordingly, sanction is accorded for Construction of an Anicut across the Thenar River to feed Oyyakondan tank and other tanks near O.Siruvayal Village of Karaikudi Taluk in Sivagangai District at an estimated cost of Rs.5.42 Crore (Rupees Five crore and forty two lakh only) in anticipation of NABARD loan assistance under RIDF XXVII for 2021-2022.

Out of Rs.5,42,00,000/-, a sum of Rs.1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One crore only) earmarked for financial year 2021 - 2022 and the balance amount will be released on the next financial year based on need.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following new head of account :- (40-01)

05 Pampar Kottakariyar Basin - 800 - Other Expenditure -
State's Expenditure - FB -BARRAGE - NABARD Assistance -
416 - Major Works - 01 Major Works.

7. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority for the above said new Head of Account.

8. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned are directed to open the above new Head of Account in their books.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai-5 is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for

sanction of same as advance from Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of advance from Contingency Fund will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department. Further, he is also directed to send necessary draft explanatory notes for the inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate for the 2021 - 2022 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.53283/PW-II/22, dated 25.01.2022 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 1492 (One thousand four hundred and ninety two)
