ORDER:

During the Budget presented for the year 2021- 2022 on 13.08.2021, the Hon'ble Minister (Finance & HRM) had announced that "This Government will formulate Schemes to restore the reservoir capacity for important dams including Mettur, Amaravathy, Vaigai and Pechipparai. Subsequently during the Water Resources Department's Demand for Grants for the year 2021 - 2022 held on 23.08.2021, the Hon'ble Minister (Water Resources) had made an announcement that "Necessary action will be taken to restore the storage capacity of the Mettur, Amaravathy, Vaigai, Pechipparai, Gundar, Ramanathi & Willington Dams and Kaveripakkam Tank."

2. Based on the above announcement, the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department has sent a proposal for engaging a consultancy service for preparation of Detailed Project Report including silt accumulation survey and silt analysis for finding out suitability for revenue model for the work of Desilting and raising

of Full Tank Level of Kaveripakkam Tank at an estimated cost of Rs.65.00 lakh.

- 3. The Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation has requested to accord administrative sanction for engaging a Consultant for "Preparation of Detailed Project Report including silt accumulation survey and silt analysis for finding out suitability for revenue model for the work of Desilting and raising of Full Tank Level of Kaveripakkam Tank in Nemili Taluk of Ranipet District at an estimated cost of Rs.65.00 Lakh, including advertisement charges of Rs.5.00 lakh by calling for tenders.
- 4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the above proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department. Accordingly, administrative sanction is accorded for engaging a qualified Consultant for preparation of Detailed Project Report including silt accumulation survey and silt analysis for finding out suitability for revenue model for the work of Desilting and raising of Full Tank Level of Kaveripakkam Tank in Nemili Taluk of Ranipet District at an estimated cost of Rs.65,00,000/-(Rupees Sixty five lakh only)
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2701 – Medium Irrigation – 80 – General – 001 – Direction and Administration - State's Expenditure – JI – Investigation of Projects on Surveying and Levelling Operations etc., - 317 Minor Works - 01 Minor Works.

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.65,00,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2022 – 2023. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of legislature by way of Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2022 – 2023. Pending provision of funds, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is directed to include the above item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal of Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2022 – 2023 and also send necessary draft Explanatory Note for inclusion of the expenditure in the

Supplementary Estimate 2022 – 2023 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
