ORDER:

During the Water Resources Department's Demand for grants for the year 2021-2022 held on 23.08.2021, the Hon'ble Minister of Water Resources has announced on the floor of Assembly that "The offices of the Water Resources Department are functioning in rental buildings at various places. Many offices are functioning in old buildings. Therefore, it is proposed to construct new buildings for Regular Divisions and Sub Division, Staff quarters, IHH Poondi, Quality Control Division and Sub division and Laboratories in a phased manner in 5 years"

2. Based on the above announcement, the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department, in his letter read above, has sent a proposal for the work of Construction / Reconstruction of 9 office buildings for Madurai Region of Water Resources Department at an estimated cost of Rs.252.70 lakh and the Works envisage the following:

1. Construction of Section Office Building of P.C Patti Section, AE Quarters and Compound wall at P.C Patti in Theni Taluk in Theni District for Estimate Amount of Rs.43.00 Lakhs.

The Irrigation section at Palanichettipatti is maintaining 2 Anicuts and 3 channels in Cumbum valley double crop ayacuts and 17 tanks. The

Section has its Jurisdiction from Uppukottai Anicut to P.C Patti Gauging section at P.C Patti. The P.W.D campus at Veerapandi is located at 1.0 Km from the Veerapandi temple. At present there is no section office building for the Palanichettipatti section. Since the Assistant Engineer at Palanichettipatti section has to reside within the campus building at all times, it is very difficult to manage the section without an office building. All the essential files, Instruments, office furniture are kept inside the Assistant Engineer quarters of the PWD campus at Palanichettipatti section. In case of inspection at the section office, it is very difficult to manage the office and personal belongings. The existing PWD campus at Veerapandi is located at the outskirts of the Veerapandi Village and there is no compound wall surrounding the campus. In order to protect the campus from animals and anti social elements, it is very much essential to provide compound wall for the PWD campus at Veerapandi. Hence, it is proposed to construct section office and estimate prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

2. Construction of Section Office Building in Manjalar Dam of Periyakulam Taluk in Theni District for an Estimated Amount of Rs.38.50 Lakh.

Manjalar Dam Section office Building is under the control of Manjalar Basin Sub Division, Periyakulam. The above section building was constructed 50 years ago. It is very old and under damaged conditions. The above building is in dilapidated condition and dampness during rainy season affects the walls and joinery works, which causes inconvenience for the people working there. The roof slab rods are exposed and it may fall at any time. Hence, the Ramanadhikal section office is not functioning in the existing building at present. Hence, construction of a new section office is very essential and to be done immediately to avoid further damage and loss. Hence it is proposed to construct section office and estimate prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

3. Reconstruction of South main channel Section Office Building in Thenthiruperai in Eral Taluk of Thoothukudi District. Estimate Amount of Rs.21.20 Lakhs.

South Main channel Section office Building is under the control of Lower Thambraparani Basin Sub Division, Srivaikundam. The above section office building was constructed 100 years ago. There are 1 No of Anicut, supply channels and 15 Nos of system tank maintained by this section under Thambraparani Basin Irrigation system. It is very old and under damaged conditions. The above building is in dilapidated condition and dampness during rainy season affects the walls and joinery works, which causes inconvenience for habitation.

The roof is fully damaged and it may fall at any time. Hence, Thenthiruperai section office is not functioning in the building at present. Hence, the construction of a new section office is very essential and to be done immediately to avoid further damage and loss. Hence, it is proposed to construct section office and estimate prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

4. Construction of Perungal Section Office Building at Manimuthar in Ambasamudram Taluk of Tirunelveli District. Estimate Amount of Rs.21.00 Lakhs.

Perungal Section office Building is under the control of Manimuthar Dam Sub Division, Manimuthar. There are supply channels and 35 Nos. of system tank maintained by this section under Manimuthar system. The above section office building was constructed in 1958. It is very old and is in damaged conditions. The above building is in dilapidated condition and dampness during rainy season affects the walls and joinery works which causes inconvenience for habitation. The roof is exposed and it may fall at any time. Hence, the Perungal section office is not functioning in the existing building at present. Hence, the construction of a new section office is very essential and to be done immediately to avoid further damage and loss. Hence, it is proposed to construct section office and estimate prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

5. Reconstruction of Ramanadhikal Section Office Building at Ambasamudram Taluk of Tirunelveli District. Estimate Amount of Rs.21.00 Lakhs.

Ramanadhikal Section office Building is under the control of Chittar Basin Sub Division, Ambasamudram. The above section building was constructed 50 years ago. There are 3 Nos of Anicuts, supply channels and 14 Nos of system tank maintained by this section under Gadana system. The above section office building was constructed in 1970-1971. It is very old is in damaged conditions. The above building is in dilapidated condition and dampness occurs during rainy season which affects the walls and joinery works which causes inconvenience for habitation. The roof slab rods are exposed and it may fall at any time. Hence, the Ramanadhikal section office is not functioning in the existing building at present. Hence, the construction of a new section office is very essential and to be done immediately to avoid further damage and loss. Hence, it is proposed to construct section office and estimate prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

6. Construction of Section Office Building for Irrigation Section, Alwarkurichi at Alwarkurichi Village of Tenkasi Taluk of Tenkasi District. Estimate Amount of Rs. 21.00 Lakhs.

PWD Section office for Irrigation section, Alwarkurichi under the control of Chittar Basin Sub Division, Ambasamudram is functioning in a Temporary building for Rent in Private building in Alwarkurichi Village of Tenkasi Taluk. The Irrigation section is one of the section of Water Regulation of Gadana Reservoir system. The Alwarkurichi Anicut is First Anicut of Gadana system. This section office maintains 5 Nos of Irrigation tanks, Alwarkurichi Anicut, Adaichani Anicut and their channels. During flood period and water Irrigation period, operation of water regulation is done for these Anicuts by this section. The meeting of W.U.A of Gadana system are to be conducted to discuss water regulation related matters during both Kar and Pisanam at this office building. Hence, it is essential to construct a permanent section office building. There is no permanent section office building for the above section office. So it is proposed to construct a new building for this section and estimate prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

7. Construction of New Section Office Building for Gundar Basin section, Sedapatti in Peraiyur Taluk of Madurai District. Estimate Amount of Rs.14.50 Lakhs.

It is Proposed to Construction one Section Office building for Sedapatti section at Sedapatti Union office compound at Sedapatti Village in Peraiyur Taluk of Madurai District. Sedapatti section office is maintaining tanks and Anicuts in Sedapatti area under Gundar Basin Jurisdiction. There is no office building for this section. Hence, necessary rough cost estimate is prepared for the construction of Section Office building for Sedapatti Village in Peraiyur Taluk of Madurai District based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, PWD, Chennai.

8. Construction of New Section Office Building for Gundar Basin section, Peraiyur in Peraiyur Taluk of Madurai District. Estimate Amount of Rs.14.50 Lakh.

Peraiyur Section office is Maintaining tanks and Anicuts in Sedapatti area under Gundar Basin Jurisdiction. There is no office Building for this section. Hence, it is proposed to construct one section office building for Peraiyur Section at Peraiyur Taluk office compound at Peraiyur Village in Peraiyur Taluk of Madurai.

9. Construction of integrated sub division Office Building for Gundar Basin Sub Division, Kamuthi and Kamuthi Section office 1 & 2 (first floor) in Kamuthi Taluk of Ramanathapuram District. Estimate Amount of Rs.58.00 Lakh.

The Proposed Construction of Integrated sub division office building for Gundar Basin Sub Division, Kamuthi and Kamuthi section office 1 & 2 (First floor) will be constructed at survey No.281/1 at Kamuthi Village in Kamuthi Taluk of Ramanathapuram District. The existing Gundar Basin Sub Division, Kamuthi is in deteriorated condition and till now there is no separate office building for Kamuthi section 1 & 2. Therefore, necessary rough cost estimate is prepared based on the drawing evolved by the Chief Architect, Public Works Department, Chennai.

3. The Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department has informed that all the above schemes are prepared based on the Schedule of Rates for the Year 2021-22 and requested to accord Administrative Sanction for the proposal for "Construction / Reconstruction of 9 office buildings for Madurai Region of Water Resources Department at an estimated cost of Rs.2.527 Crore.

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department. Accordingly, sanction is accorded for Construction / Reconstruction of 9 office buildings for Madurai Region of Water Resources Department at an estimated cost of Rs.2.527 Crore (Rupees Two crore, fifty two lakhs and seventy thousand only) as follows:

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Engineer-In-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai-5, is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with copy of this order for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. He is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in Supplementary Estimate 2021 - 2022 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time.
